World Book Day

Reading with your child can have long-lasting benefits for their future. There are a lot of ways that you can help your child get more out of reading a story, reading together for just 10 minutes a day can make a difference. STRIVE to make your child a more confident reader by following these strategies.

Support- praise and encourage your child before, after and during reading.

Tell- can your child tell what will happen next?

Retrieve- can your child find the answer in the story if you ask questions?

Infer- can your child use clues for the story to say how someone might be feeling or what might happen?

Vocabulary-can your child discuss why the author used certain vocabulary in a text?

Evaluate- can your child explain why or why not they enjoyed what they read?
